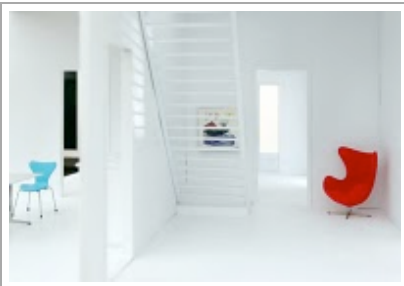

Minimii Designer Dollhouse #1: Arne Jacobsen



Thanks much to TheYoupiTouch for letting me know about this **new Arne Jacobsen dollhouse** that is set to hit the market in July 2009! Based on Jacobsen's actual [villa in Charlottenlund](#), Denmark, this dollhouse produced by the Minimii company is reportedly a 1:16 structure that features magnetic walls for interior access and for hanging art and lights. Of course the company also produced miniature replicas of some of Jacobsen's popular furniture designs in a range of colors. If you missed out on having the old school and coveted Brio house that featured Jacobsen's designs, then this just might make up for it.
